



The Book of Deuteronomy Discussion Questions

Chapter 1 - God blesses His people when they follow His commands. At times, we do our own thing and there are consequences for not being obedient.

How have you experienced this in your own life?

Chapter 2 - When God is on our side, there is no battle too big to fight.

Name a time when you faced a battle that God brought you through victoriously.

Chapter 3 - Sometimes we give way to fear in the midst of life's battles. As a result, we miss out on seeing the work of God in our lives.

In what area of your life is God calling you to trust him more and not give in to your fears?

Chapter 4 - God's mercy allows us to return to Him when we have walked away. He will never forsake us!

Name a time when God showed mercy to you.

Chapter 5 - God desires that we walk in all the ways that He commands, so that we may live well.

Which of the 10 commandments do you need to apply more in your life?

Chapter 6 - The greatest commandment is that we love God. When things are going well, it is easy to lose our focus on Him and the blessings He gives.

What steps are you taking to ensure that God remains the focus of your life during the good and bad times?

Chapter 7 - Our God is mighty. We have no need to be afraid of those who stand against us.

How have you seen the mightiness of God at work in your life?

Chapter 8 - We must thank God for all that He does for us and not take credit for ourselves.

What do you need to thank God for doing in your life today?

Chapter 9 - Our sin should bring us to our knees before the Lord.

Take time to examine your heart and repent of any unconfessed sin in your life.

Chapter 10 - God requires us to fear Him, walk in His ways, love Him and serve Him with our hearts and souls.

In what ways do you live this out each day?

Chapter 11 - God warned the Israelites to pay attention, lest their hearts be deceived.

Have you been deceived in the past? How are you paying attention now, so that you will not be deceived?

Chapter 12 - God's commandments must be followed, we can not add to them nor take away from them.

How do you ensure that you're following God's commandments without adding or taking away from them?

Chapter 13 - We must take care and compare all men's words to God's Word, in order to have the truth revealed.

Have you ever had a man's words not match up to God's Word? How did you handle that situation?

Chapter 14 - All that we have belongs to God.

How are you giving back to the Lord?

Chapter 15 - That which God blesses us with, we must not withhold from using to help those in need.

How can you reach out and bless someone in need today?

Chapter 16 - Everything we have is a blessing from God. We need to have a willing heart to give back to Him.

How are you giving back to the Lord? How has this changed your life?

Chapter 17 - We must read God's word daily so that we learn to fear the Lord and keep His ways.

How does having a daily Bible reading time, impact your life?

Chapter 18 - God's people were warned not to practice the customs of other nations. They were meant to be different.

How do you ensure that worldly influences don't influence your life?

Chapter 19 - God provided refuge to those who had accidentally committed a sinful act.

How does this remind you of what He has done for you?

Chapter 20 - God's people were reminded not to be afraid in times of battle because He was with them.

What battle have you faced and instantly you were scared until you remembered that God was with you?

Chapter 21 - Provisions were made in the chance that guilty parties could not be found. This provision provided them with grace and redemption.

Name a problem in your life that you need to apply grace and mercy to.

Chapter 22 - Today we are reminded of the importance of remaining sexually pure both inside and outside of marriage.

In today's world, this can be a hard standard to live by. What are some ways that you have safeguarded yourself?

Chapter 23 - Vowing to God is very serious. Therefore, we need to be careful of the promises that we make to God.

Is there a vow that you have made to God that you are struggling to keep?

Chapter 24 - Providing for the less fortunate, is commanded by God.

What are some ways that you can help those around you?

Chapter 25 - In all our dealings, we must remain fair and honest. Otherwise, we are creating an act against God.

What are some ways that you can ensure that you are being fair, in all your dealings?

Chapter 26 - We are to give to God and obey Him with all our heart and soul.

What are some things or ways that you are tempted to hold back?

Chapter 27 - It is one thing to know God's commands; however, it's another thing to put them into action.

Do you sometimes struggle with this? What is it that causes you to stumble?

Chapter 28 - God promised blessings to Israel for their obedience but curses for their disobedience.

Tell of a time when God blessed you for your obedience.

Chapter 29 - God reveals through His Word, the things we need to know.

Name something God has recently revealed to you, through His Word.

Chapter 30 - Today we are reminded that God wants and longs to bless His people because He loves us.

How does this simple truth make you feel? Have you shared your appreciation with God regarding all that He has blessed you with?

Chapter 31 - Moses reminded the people that they have nothing to fear because God is with them and He will not leave them.

What is something that you need to lay at God's feet?

Chapter 32 - Moses encouraged the younger generation to ask the older generation about all that God had brought them through.

Who can you share with, about all the things that God has brought you through?

Chapter 33 - Moses left the people with encouraging words. God's people are blessed because they have God as their refuge.

How is God your refuge?

Chapter 34 - Moses died before they entered the Promise Land and yet he was at peace because he knew he had fulfilled his purpose.

What is God calling you to do? How are you fulfilling your purpose?
