

The Book of Romans Discussion/Reflection Questions

Chapter 1

Describe a time when you were ashamed to admit or share your faith with someone.

How do you wish you had handled that situation differently?

Chapter 2

The kindness of God is meant to lead us to repentance.

How has God's kindness led you to repentance? And who can you be kind to today, in hopes of leading them to repentance?

Chapter 3

There is no room for self-righteousness in the family of God. All of us are sinners and have fallen short of God's standard but through our faith in Jesus, we are redeemed!

Write your testimony. When did you realize for the first time that you were a sinner in need of Jesus and his saving grace?

Chapter 4

Today we were reminded that Abraham remained faithful even though he had to wait to receive what was promised to him by God. His faith made him righteous.

What is it that you are waiting on and how strong is your faith today?

Chapter 5

Even in our weak sinful nature, Christ died for us!

Think back to the life that you had before Christ, how has it changed?

Chapter 6

As Christians, we live under grace.

How does this give you the strength to rid yourself of things that God is convicting you to release, so you can serve Him better?

Chapter 7

Though we are made new in Christ, all of us struggle with sin in our lives.

What is one thing you know is right to do but you struggle to live out in your life?

Chapter 8

God is always at work in our lives bringing about his purpose and good.

How does knowing that His plans are good, for those who love him, bring you peace and comfort today?

Chapter 9

It is the grace of God that allows us to be called 'his people' and 'his beloved.'

What have you learned about God's grace so far in our study of the book of Romans? Take a moment to write a prayer of thanks to God for His abundant grace.

Who was the first person that you introduced to Jesus?

Sometimes it is hard to understand God's ways. God's ways are so much higher than man's.

How does knowing that God's depth of riches, wisdom and knowledge comfort you, as you seek to follow Him and His Word?

Chapter 12

One of the marks of a believer is peace.

What are some ways that you can show Christian love and peace, to those who are being difficult in your life today?

Chapter 13

The second greatest commandment is that we love one another.

Who do you "owe" love to today? Write down a way that you can show love to this person this week.

Chapter 14

A stumbling block is someone who is a more mature believer, who takes liberty in their choices, and then causes a younger believer to fall.

In what ways can you make sure that you are not becoming a stumbling block to another believer?

Chapter 15

Jesus is the hope of the Jews and the Gentiles.

Share how your hope in Jesus is lived out in your daily life.

Chapter 16

We are to love people but we are also to love truth. While we are to avoid divisions, we are also called to avoid those who cause division. This is not an easy teaching.

How do you guard yourself against those who cause division between you and your beliefs?
